## Engineering for Kids

Engineering for Kids provides STEM based Academic Enrichment Programs for children ages 4 to 14. Our mission is to prepare students for the global economy by providing programs focused on Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM). Our inquiry based programs are designed to be an exciting, fun, hands-on, experience with STEM related projects. We offer curriculum correlating to the following national standards: Science (NSES), Technology and Engineering (ITEEA), and Mathematics (NCTM).

**Jr. Aerospace and Jr. Chemical (5 weeks for each program, 10 weeks total)**

**Jr. Chemical Engineering:** The Junior Chemical Engineering curriculum introduces our youngest engineers to fundamental concepts of solids, liquids, and solutions. Students investigate the properties of several crazy concoctions and make their own samples of bubbles, play dough, flub, and more! Calling all engineers!

**Aerospace and Industrial Engineering (5 weeks for each program, 10 weeks total)**

**Grades 3-5      Fee: \$275**

**Aerospace Engineering:** Students use the Engineering Design Process to design, create, test, and refine a variety of flying machines. They construct a shock absorbing system designed to protect two marshmallow astronauts in a lunar vehicle, create their own air-powered rockets, and assemble a model blimp that actually takes flight!

**Industrial Engineering:** Students explore foundational concepts of industrial engineering such as: assembly lines, safety, and stamping, sorting and distributing materials. Students see just how fun and creative industrial engineering can be as they create their own ice cream factory and 3-D models of designs. Let's learn about efficient systems for production!
